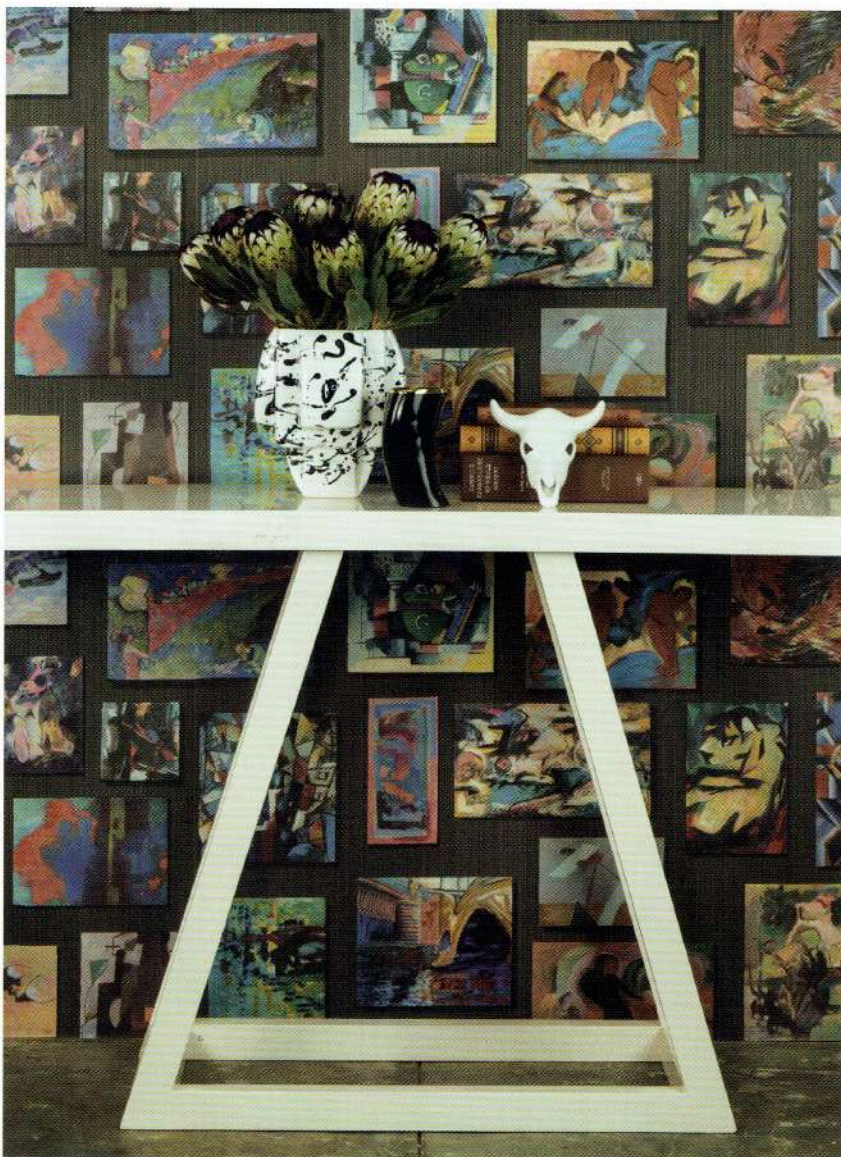
MONCLER
